

HOMEWORK, TESTS AND DETENTIONS

Homework is an important part of the learning process as it helps reinforce concepts taught in class. When it is assigned, every student is expected to complete it fully and return it at the designated time. If a student does not have his/her homework completed by the due date, they will still be able to complete it for late credit. The student's grade will be no better than a 75% if they choose to turn in their work one day late. Any work that is turned in later than one day late will be given minimal (but passing) credit. Homework will account for 25% of a student's grade. Assessments (tests, quizzes, projects, etc.) will account for 75% of a student's grade. If a student turns in an incomplete assignment they will be given the paper back in order to complete it for late credit. If a student wants to take a re-test they may do so with a parent signature on their original test by showing up at the designated re-test time (usually before school).

If a student is absent for an assignment, he/she will be given an additional day per day absent to complete the work.

An assignment that is never turned in will result in a failing grade. If a student has chronic late/missing assignments, that student will be dealt with on an individual basis. This may include having a student/teacher conference and/or a parent contact.

Detentions will also be given AUTOMATICALLY if inappropriate behavior occurs when a guest teacher is in the classroom.

I hope that you will encourage your child's best efforts at all times, and I know that your high expectations will result in a super year of knowledge, maturation, and responsibility.
